
**Presentations** – Ms. Spaulding stated that she would be giving an Ethics Presentation as early as next month's meeting.

2. Policy 2431 – Athletic competition: most Camden County Leagues are for 6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grade students.
